## **SHREDSTATION™ LAUNCHES HOME AND SMALL BUSINESS DOCUMENT AND COMPUTER DESTRUCTION SERVICE**

### ***ShredStation Express™ Brings Secure Shredding Pick-up Service to Fairfield County***

**Fairfield, CT – September 12, 2007** – ShredStation, maker of the document destruction industry's first self-pay secure deposit station, ShredStation Vaults, has announced that it is now offering a home and small business document and e-media destruction service, ShredStation Express™. The new service allows consumers and small businesses with larger destruction needs (multiple boxes) to place orders online or by phone and schedule the pick-up and destruction of documents, computers and other electronic media.

The service is being offered to residents and businesses in all of Fairfield County. Pick-ups will be scheduled seven days a week.

"The demand for retail document destruction is growing at an amazing rate," said Al Villamil, President, ShredStation, Inc. "If you aren't a big company with ongoing destruction needs, shredding companies have all but ignored you. We wanted to make sure that the needs of the individual consumer and even smaller businesses are being met. Whether its when people move into a new home or when people simply realize that they've kept their documents long enough, we're seeing a strong demand for our service –and people really like the added convenience of never having to leave home, not to mention not needing a home shredder."

#### **How ShredStation Express works:**

1. A customer places and order and schedules a pick up online at [www.shredstation.com](http://www.shredstation.com) or by calling 1-877-SHREDXP.
2. A Certified Destruction Agent will confirm the pick-up day and time and arrive at the designated pick-up site when scheduled.
3. The Agent takes the boxes to a ShredStation Secure Destruction Facility and destroys all materials.
4. The customer receives a Certificate of Destruction via mail or email.

"In many cases it is cost-prohibitive and impractical to send a 30 foot industrial shredding truck into a residential neighborhood to destroy only a small amount of material," said Robert Johnson, Executive for National Association for Information Destruction (NAID). "As a result, the individual consumer is suffering from a shortage of document destruction options. I'm pleased to see that ShredStation is leading the charge in this unfamiliar territory and answering this consumer demand."

ShredStation Express requires a minimum fee of \$59.99 for residential or business pick up service and can handle orders of any number of boxes (prices are based on average box size of 12"h x 12"w x 24"d and a weight of roughly 30lbs.).

The company will also destroy old desktop computers, laptop computers, cell phones, PDAs, DVDs, CDs, tapes, microfilm and other electronic media. Electronic media destruction starts at \$9.99. All materials (paper and electronic media) are destroyed to professional standards and recycled.

ShredStation Express is currently serving several markets in Pennsylvania and Connecticut and plans to expand to serve more than 10 states by the second quarter of 2008.
